Ventrodorsal maxilla, open mouth. Mouth is opened, with hard palate parallel to table surface. Pull mandible caudally and secure it. Secure endotracheal tube and tongue to center of mandible or pull the tube and tongue caudally to one side of the mandible. Angle x-ray beam 20° from perpendicular (if possible).

CORRECT POSITIONING OF THE PSP • Orient the PSP plate so that it is as parallel as possible to the long axes of the teeth. ◦ This is accomplished by placing the buccal cusps of the maxillary teeth in the FIRST or SECOND GROOVE of the biteblock. ◦ This will place the upper edge of the PSP plate at or across the midline of the palate.
